Child Friendly Version of Child Protection Policy

To help you decide what could be a 'problem' and whom you should talk to.

Bullying

If you think a member of the group or a grown up is bullying you.

You must tell a parent/carer, class teacher/teaching assistant or one of the Buddies as soon as you can.

Do not keep it a secret.

Saying funny things to you

If a member of the group or a grown up says something to you or you hear something that you do not like or upsets you.

You must tell a parent/carer, class teacher/teaching assistant or one of the Buddies as soon as you can.

Do not keep it a secret.

Touching you

If a member of the group or a grown up touches you on a part of your body like your bottom, chest or anywhere else you do not like.

You must tell a parent/carer, class teacher/teaching assistant or one of the Buddies as soon as you can.

Do not keep it a secret.

Trying to give you tablets, cigarettes, beer or wine

If a member of the group or a grown up asks you if you want a tablet or asks you to smoke a cigarette, or have a drink of something and you do not know what it is. Do not eat, drink or smoke what they are giving you.

You must tell a parent/carer, class teacher/teaching assistant or one of the Buddies as soon as you can.

Do not keep it a secret.

Hitting, punching or smacking you

If a member of the group or a grown up hits, punches or smacks you or hurts you in any way.

You must tell a parent/carer, class teacher/teaching assistant or one of the Buddies as soon as you can.

Do not keep it a secret.
