# Family Learning – FUN WITH FORCES

We have invited the Family Learning Team into our school on Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> October.

If you have a child in Year 3, Year 4, Year 5 or Year 6, you are invited to come into school between 1:30pm and 3:00pm to take part in a fun Science workshop with your children. During this time you can join your child(ren) complete a variety of fun, practical activities based around the KS2 Forces science curriculum. The investigational based tasks have been designed to provoke discussion between you and your child(ren) in a relaxed, inspiring atmosphere — and deepen their knowledge and understanding of this aspects of the curriculum.

Unfortunately, only those children who have an adult with them can take place in this session – which will be led by Sarah Wild and Jo Pritchard (who some of you will have met if you have attended any of the Phonics, Reading or Mathematics Family Learning events that we have hosted previously).

If you wish to take part, please send us a message – via Studybugs – with FUN WITH FORCES as the 'subject' of the message. The message needs to include the name of the parent(s)/carer(s) who will be attending – along with name of the KS2 children who will be taking part in the session with them.

The activities will focus on friction slopes, magnetism, force in action and famous scientists.
