Parents' Evening

When the children return to school after half term, we will begin planning for our first Parents' Evening.

You will be able to select which of these options works best for you on a reply slip attached to the letter that will be sent out on 1st November.

Further details will be sent out during the first week in November. However, please be aware the dates for these appointments will be Wednesday 17th November and Thursday 18th November.
